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2016 Path to the Runoffs



The 2016 National Championship Runoffs will be held at Mid Ohio! If you have a Runoffs eligible car and would like to attend there are 2 separate paths to choose from to qualify for an invitation:

1. **The U.S. Majors** - Participate in 3 Majors weekends minimum, Finish 3 Races minimum AND finish in the top 10 in points for your class in the Conference (Western for SoPac Drivers) Or in the top 50% in points in your class Nationwide.

The Western Conference Schedule:

2. **The SoPac Division Path to the Runoffs** -

Driver must participate in 4 weekends and finish 7 races and finish in the top 3 of their class to qualify for the Runoffs. (Participation is defined as turning a wheel on the racing surface during a

wheel on the racing surface during a weekend, finishing is defined as completing 50% of the laps of a sanctioned race.)

All SoPac Racing events will count towards the Divisional Path to the Runoffs A driver may only count his top seven finishes. Points will be the same as the Majors Points system.
