

Club Sports 2000 Rules
California Sports Car Club
Effective January 1, 2004

The intent of this class is to create a class which will be appealing to most Sports 2000 owners and particularly to those with older, less aerodynamic chassis.

1. Eligible cars are those manufactured before December 31, 1985, with onboard suspensions (i.e., shock absorbers and springs must be mounted outside the monocoque with at least one end of each shock attached directly to the lower "A" arm; on all four corners of the car).
2. Exceptions to Rule 1 above, but acceptable as Club Sports 2000 is the Tiga SC85.
3. All cars entered as Club Sports 2000 must comply with all safety rules in the SCCA General Competition Rules (GCR) and Sports 2000 specification book except as noted in these rules.
4. Club Sports 2000 cars must display the class designation as CS2.
